Do you have current-day or vintage farm equipment? Are you a farm equipment dealer?

Promoting agriculture: There's no space fee, and each exhibitor or dealer will be assigned one or two 20'x20' based on footprint requirements. All exhibitors are encouraged to bring supporting exhibits/storyboards, posters, supporting documents, etc. of their equipment. Static displays are authorized, so you are not required to be present during the fair.

Logistics: A tractor with a 1-ton forklift will be available to help unload and load your equipment if necessary. **Entries Arrive:** Thursday, the week of the fair from 9 am to 3:00 pm only. At 3 pm the gate is used exclusively for animals and livestock and the AG display area is then cordoned off with a safety rope.

Entries Released: Sunday, the week of the fair at 4:00 pm. Must be removed by 5:30pm.

Safety & Security: To ensure safety, all exhibits are roped and fair attendees may cross the rope only with your permission. All exhibitors must read General Rules, Entry Rules, and Department Rules prior to entering. The AG Superintendent and staff reside on the grounds day and night, so your equipment will be monitored while on the grounds.
